CHAMPAGNE

1 House Champagne NV **£ 35.00**

Tribaut Brut Reserve

The Brut Reserve blend of 30% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir and 30% Pinot Meunier is given 3 years age on the lees before release. This allows the development of fine, persistent bubbles, fruit and yeasty aromas and well balanced palate

2 Laurent Perrier Brut NV **£ 39.95**

Pale gold in colour with a delicate and complex nose and hints of citrus and white fruits. Fresh and easy on the palate with full flavours, plenty of fruit, good balance and length

3 Lanson Rose NV **£ 46.95**

Beautiful pure colour with pale salmon touches, it is well rounded and fresh. This wine has harmonious balance and good length on the finish

4 Bollinger Special cuvee NV **£ 53.75**

A true expression of great Champagne. Its full rich character is derived from oak cask fermentation and a high proportion of Pinot Noir which gives the wine its backbone and flavour

5 Dom Perignon 1996 **£ 115.00**

An elegant and world famous Champagne with a toasted honey aroma and complex, rich fruit flavours

SPARKLING WINE

6 Mont Marcal - Cava Brut Reserva NV **£ 18.50**

Penedes (Spain)

Aged for 18 months on the lees to add fresh yeasty aromas to ripe apple and creamy flavours, giving exceptional balance, fine aromas and a persistent mousse

WHITE BURGUNDY

7 Macon Blanc Villages 2003/04 **£ 15.50**

Caves de Lugny

A balance of good fruity flavour and acidity create a delightful dry white Burgundy

8 Petit Chablis 2003 £ 18.95
Domaine de la Pauliere ½ £ 9.75
Straw yellow colour full “toasty” bouquet, firm, supple fruit
and a long lasting finish. A superb Chablis from this top grower

9 Chablis – 1er Cru Mont de Milieu 2003 £ 29.95
Domaine Alain Gautheron
Fresh, floral aromas, appley fruit and complex, rich mineral
character. Fermentation and maturation is very traditional
avoiding wood, to preserve the fresh steely flavours

RED BORDEAUX

10 Chateau Moulin Brule 2002 £ 18.75
Lussac St Emilion
A well rounded, soft spicy red with good length of flavour

11 Chateau Beau-site 2000 £ 23.95
Cru Bourgeois Exceptionel, - St Estephe
A deeply coloured, powerful red, fruity with a hint of oak,
elegance and charming with a long finish. Chateau bottled

RED BURGUNDY AND BEAUJOLAIS

12 Beaujolais Villages 2002/03 £ 16.00
Georges Blanc ½ £ 8.50
A small eight hectare domain producing a distinguished
fruity and balanced red, supple and generous and allowing
the Gamay grape to develop its full potential

13 Fleurie – Chateau de la Verne 2002 £ 24.75
Deep coloured with a bouquet of apricots, full bodied,
distinguished and harmonious

14 Nuits St Georges – “Vieilles Vignes” 2000 £ 35.50
Domaine Alain Michelot
The Nuits St Georges Vieilles Vignes comes from 75 year old
Pinot Noir vines. It has considerable weight, extraction, ripe fruit
character and big, soft tannins all contributing to a long satisfying finish

RHONE VALLEY

15 Cotes du Rhone – “Parallele45” 2001 £ 15.75
Paul Jaboule Aine
A fruity, fleshy blend of syrah and Grenache grapes, very dark
cherry in colour with an intense, rich and spicy bouquet and
a background of ripe cassis

LOIRE VALLEY

16 Sauvignon de Touraine 2003/04 £ 14.95

Domaine de la Bergerie

Winemaker Jackie Marteau is one of the Loire's finest exponents of the Sauvignon Blanc grape, capturing the expressive gooseberry flavours whilst retaining an excellent balance of flavour and clean zingy finish

17 Sancerre – L'Enjoue 2003 £ 23.50

A clear, Golden colour with a fragrance of gooseberries, full flavoured on the palate with good depth and length

ROSE WINE

18 Mateus Rose NV £ 14.95

A medium dry, slightly sparkling rose, from Portugal, attractively packaged in unique "flask shaped bottle"

19 Pinot Grigio Ramato – "Il Barco" 2003/04 £ 14.25

ITALY

20 Pinot Grigio – Portenova 2004 £ 15.25

A light and elegant dry white. Pinot Grigio is a very easy going varietal, showing delicate perfume and youthful freshness. It can be easy drinking and can happily match light foods

21 Chianti – Fontella 2003 £ 15.95

Full fruit character and a firm tannic finish. Good colour, lovely ripe Sangiovese on the palate and well balanced with the maximum amount of fruit character

AUSTRALIA

22 Cabernet Sauvignon 2002 £ 16.75

Cedar Creek, South East Australia

A well balanced blend ; medium bodied with a soft balance of oak and grape tannins

23 Chardonnay 2003 £ 15.75

Cedar Creek, South East Australia

A dry "buttery" white showing the full flavour of the Chardonnay grape

CALIFORNIA

24 Zinfandel – Cougars Moon 2002 £ 16.25

Rich, flavourful wine with spicy berry flavours and vanilla oak nuances

SPAIN

25 Merlot – Marques de Monistrol 2003 £ 14.95
Fruit driven red with a wide range of aromas and hints of truffle, intense and complex on the palate. This is full bodied, with soft tannins and well integrated oak spice

26 Azabache – Rioja Reserva 1998 £ 19.75
Aromas of raisins, vanilla, leather and chocolate. Delicate ageing velvety texture with flavours of dry fruit, plum, game and hazelnuts. On the palate, it is complex, vigorous, lengthy, smooth and rounded, with a long warm finish

CHILE

27 Sauvignon Blanc 2004 £ 14.75
Villa Rosa, Maule Valley
Very fresh and fruity aromas, clean, flinty and deliciously refreshing

28 Cabernet Sauvignon 2003/04 £ 14.75
Villa Rosa, Maule Valley
A ripe, fruity red, well rounded with a blackcurrant character and a firm Peppery finish

NEW ZEALAND

29 Sauvignon Blanc 2004 £ 19.25
Whitehaven, Marlborough
A fresh, citrus bouquet with a peachy fruit flavour

SOUTH AFRICA

30 Chenin Blanc 2004 £ 13.95
Tulbagh Ridge, Tulbagh
This dry Chenin Blanc has aromas of honeysuckle and tropical fruit and rich flavours of citrus, melon and pineapple. It is well balanced by the natural lemony acidity of the Chenin grape

31 Pinotage 2004 £ 13.95
Tulbagh Ridge, Tulbagh
Fragrant and supple, with sweet flavours of red berry and summer fruits. Its soft, supple character and delicate rounded tannins allow easy drinking

A crisp dry white bottled in Bordeaux ; (Alc Vol 12.5%)
Good fruit balance with clean fresh taste of grape

Specially selected Vin de Pays 175ml glass £ 3.00

34 Richmond Ridge – White 2003/04 £ 12.50
Colombard Chardonnay 175ml glass £ 3.50
(South East Australia) (Alc Vol 12%)

A full bodied, dry wine style blended for early drinking. I shows full bodied varietal fruit flavours, retaining some residual sugar softness and finishing with fresh, crisp acidity

35 Richmond Ridge – Red 2003 £ 12.50
175ml glass £ 3.50

(South East Australia) (Alc Vol 13%)

A vibrant ruby red with an aroma that displays lively plum fruit characters with a hint of spice. The palate is bursting with round fleshy plum flavours, balanced by soft tannins
