### SPARKLING WINE

**1 Marçal ~ Cava Brut Reserva NV** £ 18.50  
Penedès (Spain)

*Aged for 18 months on the lees to add fresh yeasty aromas to ripe apple and creamy flavours, giving exceptional balance, fine aromas and a persistent mousse*

### CHAMPAGNE

**2 Mailly Grand Cru ~ Brut Reserve NV** £ 31.00

*This is rich, powerful Champagne is from an exceptional 'mono cru' producer using Pinot Noir grapes from the Grand Cru village of Mailly, just south of Reims, with the addition of 25% Grand Cru Chardonnay. It is flowery and biscuity on the nose with vanilla, mineral and fresh bread flavours on a complex palate. This is serious Champagne to enjoy as an aperitif or to accompany freshwater fish and white meats.*

**3 Tribaut Rose ~ Brut NV** £ 31.00

*Made from red grapes only and blended to achieve a delicate salmon pink colour. It has delicate aromas of summer fruits and complex well flavoured palate enhanced by a minimum of 4 years age before release*

**4 Laurent Perrier ~ Brut Rose NV** £ 59.50

*Attractive salmon pink colour with fine bubbles. The nose is wonderfully fresh reminiscent of summer fruits which remain on the palate. Four years of age creates a supple, rounded structure and long complex finish*

**5 Moët et Chandon ~ Dry Imperial NV** £ 42.50

*The Brut Imperial is medium in weight and fruit with a fine strong mousse a generous wine of great elegance to which Chardonnay contributes hints of brioche and hazelnut*

**6 Bollinger ~ Special Cuvee NV** £ 49.95

*A true expression of great Champagne. Its full rich character is derived from oak cask fermentation and a high proportion of Pinot Noir which gives the wine its backbone and flavour*

**7 Dom Perignon 1998** £ 125.00

*On the palate the wine is full, round and complete without being opulent and expresses great harmony. The wine is firm and intense leading into a silky long finish reminiscent of preserved citrus fruit*

### WHITE BURGUNDY

**8 Macon Blanc Villages ~ Caves de Lugny 2005** £ 15.25

*A balance of good fruity flavour and acidity create a delightful dry white Burgundy*

**9 Petit Chablis ~ Domaine Gautheron 2004** £ 18.95

*Petit Chablis offers the true mineral and floral character and distinct fresh acidity of Chablis, derived from the chalky soils of this northern Burgundy district. It is fresh and vibrant with rich apple and mineral flavour that lasts well on the finish.*

**10 Chablis ~ 1er Cru Mont de Milieu 2004** £ 29.95

Domaine Alain Gautheron

*Fresh, floral aromas, apple fruit and complex, rich mineral character. Fermentation and Maturation is very traditional avoiding wood to preserve the fresh steely flavours*

## RED BORDEAUX

- 11 Château Moulin Brulé ~ Lussac St Emilion 2002** £ 18.50  
*A well rounded, soft spicy red with good length of flavour*
- 12 Château Beau-Site ~ St Estephe 2000** £ 25.00  
**Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel**  
*A deeply coloured, powerful red, fruity with a hint of oak, elegance and charming with a long finish. Chateau bottled*

## RED BURGUNDY and BEAUJOLAIS

- 13 Beaujolais Villages ~ Georges Blanc 2004** £ 15.95  
*A small eight hectare domaine producing a distinguished fruity and balanced red, supple and generous and allowing the Gamay grape to develop its full potential*
- 14 Fleurie ~ 'La Madone' Georges Blanc 2004/05** £ 22.50  
*Made from 100% Gamay grapes, this very fruity wine exhibits an aroma of wild strawberries and lush ripe flavours which have made this wine so popular.*
- 15 Nuits St Georges ~ 'Vieille Vignes' 2001** £ 35.50  
**Domaine Alain Michelot**  
*The venerable age of these vines contributes an astounding depth and richness for a village Nuits. It has considerable weight, extraction, ripe fruit character and big, soft tannins, all contributing to a Long satisfying finish*

## RHONE VALLEY

- 16 Cotes du Rhone ~ Domaine de L'Amandine 2004** £ 15.50  
*A fresh and vibrantly fruity Southern Rhône blend, which is made predominantly from Syrah with the addition of Grenache, Carignan and Cinsault. The spice and smoky aromas of the Syrah dominate the bouquet, whilst red fruits and spice compete on the palate.*
- 17 Chateauneuf du Pape ~ Domaine St Paul 2001** £ 22.50  
*A big, rich, powerful yet mature red from the vineyards of the southern Rhône. It is complex and powerful, rich with the complexity of wild herbs, cedar and pepper*

## LOIRE VALLEY

- 18 Sauvignon Blanc ~ Caves du Haut Poitou 2005** £ 14.00  
*Gold Medal Winner from the Loire Valley. Fresh, aromatic, lively dry white with delicious mouth filling fruit flavours*
- 19 Sancerre ~ Domaine Crochet 2005** £ 23.25  
*Delightful elegant and classic Sancerre with a grassy aroma and well balanced ripe flavours of apple and elderflower. Whilst rich with citrus flavours it has excellent balance and weighty fruit on the palate*

## ALSACE

- 20 Gewurztraminer ~ Paul Zinck 2004/05** £ 18.50  
*The marl and limestone rich vineyard produces full aromatic Gewürztraminer with the subtle perfume of roses, lychees and cinnamon with dry acidity and mineral nuances*

## GERMANY

- 21 Piesporter Michelsberg ~ Schmitt Sohne 2004/05** £ 13.50  
*A beautifully fragrant, medium bodied wine with up front fruit that continues to develop on the palate. Hints of peaches and green apples that are balanced perfectly with crisp acidity to give it a clean, fresh finish*

## ITALY

**22 Pinot Grigio ~ Portenova, Veneto 2005** £ 14.95

*A light and elegant dry white. Pinot Grigio is a very easy going varietal, showing delicate perfume and youthful freshness. It can be easy drinking and can happily match light foods*

**23 Chianti ~ Tenuta L'ugo, Tuscany 2003** £ 15.95

*This soft and rounded Tuscan wine is a modern style of Chianti, made to emphasise the ripe and vibrant fruit, which is a blend of Sangiovese and Canaiolo. It is full bodied, with good fresh fruit, a touch of oak from a brief maturation in barrel and a bittersweet finish*

## AUSTRALIA

**24 Copperstone Creek Chardonnay 2005** £ 15.50

South Eastern Australia

*Straw yellow in colour, this wine immediately invites you to experience the abundance of tropical, peach and citrus flavours evident on the nose.*

**25 Parri Estate Semillon ~ Southern Fleurie 2004** £ 16.50

*Citrus, gooseberry and grassy aromas prevail. The palate is crisp and lean with good length. Hints of creaminess from the wild ferment add texture and firm acidity finishes a fresh and zesty style*

**26 Cedar Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2002/04** £ 15.95

South Eastern Australia

*An attractive red wine which displays plum and cherry fruit on the palate, soft vanilla notes and a rounded finish*

**27 Simon Hacket Shiraz ~ McLaren Vale 2003/04** £ 16.50

*Medium purple red with a marvellous light spicy aroma coupled with luscious sweet berry and toasty vanilla notes. Eucalypt, plum and cherry flavours make for a wine of robustness*

## CALIFORNIA

**28 Cougars Moon Zinfandel 2002** £ 16.50

*Zinfandel is admired for its rich, concentrated fruit character and gentle tannins. Cougars Moon has the typical hallmarks of raspberry, blackberry and cinnamon spice backed by ripe and subtle tannins*

## SPAIN

**29 Rioja Crianza ~ 'Azabache' 2003** £ 17.95

Bodegas Aldeanueva

*This excellent Rioja is well balanced with a soft seductive character typical of the Tempranillo and Garnacha grapes. It is in the traditional style of the Rioja having been aged for three years in oak and bottle before release and exhibits intense fruits with hints of vanilla and a soft rounded palate.*

## CHILE

**30 La Playa Sauvignon Blanc 2005/06** £ 14.50

Colchagua Valley

*Highly aromatic wine with strong notes of citrus fruits and flowers together with a pleasant subtle touch of fresh grass and ripe pineapples.*

**31 La Playa Merlot ~ Colchagua Valley 2004** £ 14.50

*Good aromatic intensity and richness of ripe blackberries and blackcurrants. Soft tannins and gentle flavors complete the package of this truly ripe varietal Merlot wine.*

## NEW ZEALAND

### **32 Wairau River Sauvignon Blanc ~ Marlborough 2005** £ 17.95

*Wairau River Sauvignon Blanc is a quintessential aromatic grass and gooseberry Marlborough wine. The 2005 is an acclaimed Sauvignon Blanc, winning Gold at the Air NZ awards. It is a classic expression of the dry, gooseberry, grass and passion fruit style of Sauvignon that has made Marlborough world-famous.*

## SOUTH AFRICA

### **33 Sauvignon Blanc Colombar 'John B' 2005/06** £ 13.95

Rietvallei Estate, Robertson

*This fresh dry rounded blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Colombar has a lovely floral bouquet with intense fruit flavours on the palate and a well-balanced acidity, which makes for a zesty, long-lasting finish. It is easy drinking and accessible with nice weight and peachy flavour. It makes a good match for seafood and white meats.*

### **34 Tulbagh Ridge Pinotage ~ Tulbagh 2004** £ 13.95

*Fragrant and supple with sweet flavours of red berry and summer fruits. Its soft, supple character and delicate rounded tannins allow easy drinking*

## ROSE WINE

### **35 Pinot Grigio Ramato ~ il Barco 2005** £ 13.95

*A delicate salmon pink rosé, a rare wine style that has become greatly sought after & very fashionable in Italy. A delicate perfumed aroma of peach and rose petals and soft, red fruit flavours on the palate*

### **36 Mateus Rose NV** £ 14.75

*The most famous of the rose wines, slightly sparkling, easy drinking and medium sweet*
